

## McKinney Little League (MLL) NEW Uniform Instructions

Start on the MLL page of the High 5 Sports and Logos website: [www.high5sportsandlogos.com/mckinneybaseball](http://www.high5sportsandlogos.com/mckinneybaseball)  
Three steps: 1) Fill out the Team Information form. 2) Design your jersey using the online builder and instructions below. 3) High 5 Sports will review your jersey and set up your team store where you will enter the roster information. You will not enter it during the design process.

The league is providing a jersey and a MLB Replica cap for each player. Coaches and parent shirts can be purchased on your team store. A coach or parent will pick up the uniforms at High 5 Sports and Logos and hand them out to the team the week of 2/23/26.

### Design Instructions (from the website above)

You can use as many colors, patterns and outlines as you like, so have some fun with it. Don't worry about making the text size or placement perfect. We will make sure everything is centered and proportionally correct.

- From the website, choose the jersey style: Crewneck or Vneck.
- Step 1 is choosing your colors. The primary color is your main body color. Colors 2 and 3 are accent colors. You will see a preview of how the colors look on all of the design templates. Once you select a design you will have the ability to change the colors again on the next step. **Please note, colors on your screen may differ from the actual color.** We have printed color swatches and sample jerseys in store for your reference. If you have time, we recommend stopping by our store to look at the colors.
- Click on your desired design.
- Click on a color in the FILL section to make a change. To create an ombre look, click the Gradient bar, choose two colors and click the Black/white box. Click the checkered box to remove it.
- You can also add a fill pattern like Camo or Carbon Fiber by clicking on the Pattern bar and choosing a color. Location 2 and 3 are great places to add a pattern.
- Continue finalizing your colors in all of the locations. Most designs have 4 locations.
- At the top of the box, Click on **Names/Numbers**
- Under **Team Name**, click ADD TEXT. If you want a logo instead of a team name, you can add it in a later step.
- Type in your team name. The size of the text will be adjusted to fit proportionately to each jersey.
- To change the text font, Click the "FONT & COLOR" bar and scroll to see other font options.
- Click **Outline** to add an outline color (we recommended using one of the accent colors).
- Click **Outline 2** to add a second outline color.
- Add a Front Number if desired. We do not recommend it for younger teams due to the space on a small jersey.
- Add a Player Name on back if desired. Last names are discouraged for teams younger than 6U for safety reasons. We will make name printing available on the coach and fan jerseys.
- Click Back Number and ADD TEXT- **Change the size to our standard 6" size.** The number may look small on the mock up, but it is the proper size on a youth jersey. We will adjust/center the number placement.
- Add sleeve numbers if desired.
- Logos and Flags can be added anywhere on the jersey, but you must use one of the existing stock images on the builder. The only exception is adding a Texas Flag to the sleeve.
- Click the blue Save button. You will be prompted to Register (which is quick and easy) or Log in if you have already registered. Registering will allow you to revisit your design or create additional designs to choose from.
- When saving the design, please use the teamname, coach's last name and "MLL". E.g. **Rangers Smith MLL**
- If you are ready, share by clicking the image of the Envelope/Email Design button.
- In the Dealer's Email(s), enter **TEAMSALES@H5SPORTS.COM** **This is very important.**
- In the Notes sections, Please indicate that you are with McKinney Little League and any additional information or design help requests in the NOTES section.
- We will review your design and email you with any recommended changes.
- You will NOT enter the roster. That will be done after the design is finalized.
